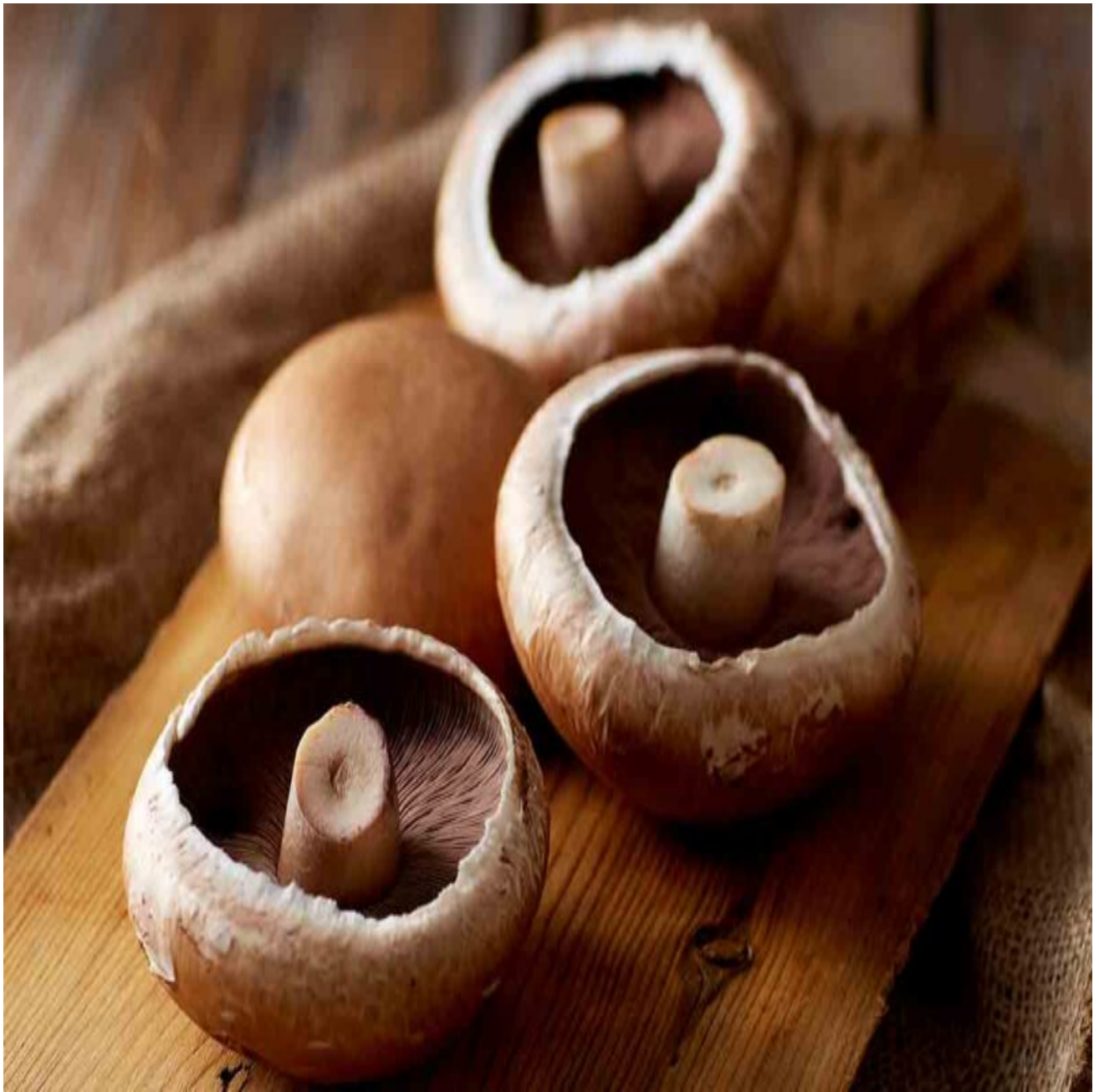

## Sustainability

- Monaghan maintain 100% Irish sourced mushrooms from SHAS approved growers.
- By 2025, the company has set a target to have a minimum of 30% recycled content in plastic packaging.
- Monaghan have implemented a research programme to identify peat replacement materials.
- At the end of 2020, solar panels were installed on Tyholland farm in Monaghan. These solar panels, will create 357,000 kWh electricity per year. This figure is roughly equal to providing 85 homes with electricity per year.
- Monaghan aim to have a 30% increase in euro donated to local community organisations by the end of 2025 from 2020 baseline.
