
TERROIR

Sustainability

•Sliabh Liag Distillers firmly believes in the importance of sustainability in all aspects of its business.

•This is reflected in the fact the company demonstrated an exemplary performance within the target areas of both energy and water throughout 2020, alongside packaging.

•Within the area of packaging, Sliabh Liag Distillers set a target to reduce the amount of non-biodegradable plastic used in the company's processors by 70% by 2021.

•Since the beginning of the plan, the company have been successful in reducing its nonbiodegradable plastic by 68%.

•To further reduce usage of non-biodegradable plastic, the goal is to replace plastic gift packaging with woods and also to return intermediate bulk

containers to suppliers for reuse.

•The company also compost distilling residue, both liquid and solid, from its gin still so that nothing is unnecessarily wasted and can be reused where possible.
